



GSL Society Presentation and Report Guidance

We are delighted to invite your school GSL Society to the Future Foundations and Global Social Leaders Conference and Awards. We now require you to prepare for your presentation at this event by submitting the following:

A Presentation via Powerpoint/Prezi AND a Project Report

1. Presentation Guidance - You will present your presentation at this event to your fellow teams, our judges and guests and our staff. We ask that your team shows us the difference you have made in the community with your social action projects and the learning your team has had during your GSL experience.

Judging Criteria: The presentations will be judged against the following criteria:

Your team's Learning/ Knowledge gained	Your Impact on the community/others:	Special Recognition
-Sharing the learning you have had as a team and the skills you have developed along the way - Demonstrating the amount of knowledge gained by the team about your community	-Measuring and demonstrating the impact made by your social action project(s) -The number of students / people/ organisations involved or impacted -The number of hours spent on the project(s)	-Involving other people in your projects -Carrying out multiple projects as a team -Creating a sustainable project

Your team presentation should focus on your social action project(s) and include:

- The project aims, measurable outcomes and who benefitted from the project
- The activities carried out to meet the outcomes and achieve the aims
- How you measured how effective your project was
- What you have learnt and what you are proud of
- What you would do differently next time to improve your project

As it is Year one for your GSL Society, you may not have completed your projects this is ok! Please do focus on your future plans and be very specific about what you will do, and how you will measure your impact.

Rules for the presentation:

- You have a maximum of 7 minutes to make your presentation (we will stop you if you run over...!)
- After the presentation there will be up to 3 minutes of questions & answers from the judging panel

Submitting your presentation: - Any PowerPoint slides or Prezi presentations and/or videos must be submitted by Sunday 12th March

- You should agree who in your team will submit your presentation
- For Prezi sharing you may need to make us an editor to share it. Please use social.leaders@future-foundations.co.uk. Videos must be able to be played without the internet (ie. not from You Tube). Please download the videos and submit with your presentation.
- If your files are above 10 MB please use '<https://www.wetransfer.com/>' and send the link to: social.leaders@future-foundations.co.uk. Please let us know your school name.

Some tips for success:

- We encourage all team members to present and take part in the presentation
- Make sure you prepare in advance and have plenty of practice as a team
- Have fun! Show enthusiasm for your project and let the judges see your personalities.

2. Project Report Guidance

- We ask that you submit a Project Report (no longer than 2 sides of A4)
- Please have a look at the example project reports given for inspiration and guidance.
- The deadline for submitting your project report is Sunday 12th March

The report is your opportunity to showcase the journey your team has been on and the progress you have made with your Social Action Project(s), whether or not you achieved your project. We want to see how much you have learned on your journey as well as how much impact you have had. The report must be a **maximum of 2 x A4 pages** and **it is up to you how you structure and present your report.**

The following things must be included in your report:

- Your team member names and team roles / responsibilities (if applicable) including your teacher's name
- At least one photo of your team and your project(s) in action
- Highlights from your experiences so far
- Outline any funds or in-kind donations (e.g. free posters, free venues or additional resources) you have secured

For ALL projects you undertook or are planning:

- The project title and project logo (if applicable)
- The aim of the project
- The outcomes and impacts of the project (see judging criteria). Include any successes or failures
- The knowledge/ learning you gained through the project
- The skills you gained through the project

Some tips for success (things we'll be looking out for):

- Keep your report simple, clear and easy to read
- Use colour, photographs and graphics to make your report as appealing as possible
- Think about creative ways to display your information
- What evidence can you show us of your impact on others? Can you use quotes, endorsements and so on?
- Make sure you check spellings thoroughly
- Get feedback from your mentors – many of them have had experience of writing reports like these
- Make sure your President and Teacher 'signs' your report to say it is a fair representation of your projects and outcomes

You must submit your presentation slides and project report using the form below by Sunday 12th March.
