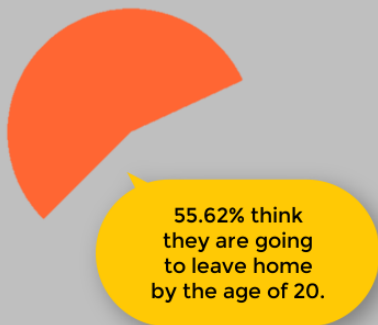

The Impact

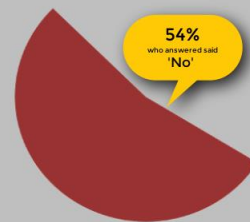
