Queen's College is a co-educational independent school located in Taunton, the county town of Somerset, England. It is a day/boarding school for children aged 0-18.

Queen's College, was founded in 1843. Queen's College's magnificent buildings and beautiful grounds combine to provide a unique and inspiring British boarding experience. The building is a symmetrical Tudor Gothic building and set in approximately 35 acres (140,000 m²) of grounds. It was built by Giles and Gane in 1874 and has been designated as a Grade II listed building. It first began admitting girls during the 1970s and is now fully coeducational.

The college's motto "Non scholae sed vitae discimus" meaning, "We educate not just for school but for life".

Queen's College is located in the South West of England in Somerset's county town, Taunton. The College is within walking distance of the town centre which offers shopping opportunities, coffee shops, a theatre, cinema and bowling.

ACCOMODATION

Queen's College provides a traditional boarding experience for students in split gender houses. The boarding houses provide spacious and comfortable accommodation, and there are a range of rooms devoted to both work and leisure. Student bedrooms are a mix of private and dormitories, and facilities include communal lounges, games rooms and a laundry.

MEALS

Meals and refreshments are provided for students and their teachers/chaperones. Most meals will be eaten in the impressive school dining hall, where a wide variety of nutritious hot food and salads are served. On excursions, students will be provided with a packed lunch.

TYPICAL EXCURSIONS

Queen's College is close to the cities of Bristol, Exeter and Bath. There are many areas of interest for cultural visits and historical tours, such as Exeter Cathedral, Bath Abbey and Bath, as well as the renowned Stonehenge. With some of the most picturesque coastline in England, the South West is a glorious destination, not to mention home to the Eden Project, the largest indoor rainforest in the world. Our courses typically includes a one-day and a half-day excursion each week.

FACILITIES

Queen's College boasts an indoor swimming pool, sports hall and a selection of well-maintained grass pitches and two Astro pitches. The school is renowned for the creative and performing arts and has excellent facilities for drama and dance.

Surrounded by the beautiful Exmoor and Dartmoor national parks, Queen's is a centre of excellence for outdoor pursuits, with some activities built into the programme.
