WHAT WE DO?-----

MOVIE NIGHT IN WCIT

In order to raise money for the books, our group has organized a Movie Night event. On Friday, March 8th, we have arranged two different rooms for the viewing of the movies and have been able to gather over 50 students who donated **over 1100 RMB** in the end of the event. From the raised 1100 RMB, we have bought another round of English and Chinese native books for the students with relatively poor English abilities in Tianjin.

In order to arrange the visit of Nankai Xiang Yu high school students of Wellington College International Tianjin, the headmaster Julian Jeffrey of Wellington College International Tianjin has sponsored the project with 2000 RMB. The sponsorship is for the arrangement of the activities for poor schools and students with relatively poor English abilities to come to WCIT for a day tour. Our group was also allowed to use our own school, Wellington College International Tianjin for the venue of movie night. Moreover, the Nankai Xiang Yu high school kindly allowed us to use their school to work with some of the students and to improve their English skills.



- We've arranged six sessions in Tianjin Nankai Xiangyu High School to improve students' English abilities:

We organized the overall field visit to have a few surveys on the levels of students and the English books in the library in NKXY. After that, we made agreements with NKXY Junior high and organized 6 sessions for them to study Biology, read native English books, analyze articles, play word games. Also, we've donated **150 English books**, and announced to invite them to WCIT to have one-day native English studying. All of the students in junior seven there have been impacted by us. Over **300 students** in junior 7 have been helped by our project. We communicated and interacted with students in NKXY in English. By doing this, the students would be able to experience how it was like to speak in English in real life, not textbook or exam-wise. We have been also sharing cultural ideas and differences to help them make a step into a new culture which we all hope will allow them to explore more in the globalized world.

We've had two speeches during the assembly in WCIT.

The first speech was about to introduce our project, and call out all our school mates in WCIT to support us by donating English books. 150 English native books have been donated by the students in WCIT. After that, for the second speech, we announced our opportunity for Tianjin NKXY High School students to our school and introduced our six sessions there to improve students' English abilities.

IN THE FUTURE, WE WILL.....

Invitation to the students from NKXY to WCIT (future plan—on May 3rd):



During May Day holiday, student representatives from NKXY will have their academic visit in WCIT in which they will have full-day lessons with WCIT students and experience native English learning which they seldom have access to. Within one-day immersion program, representative students will be able to develop a general understanding of the school curriculums and foreign learning style which will be essentially helpful for their diversification of education and integration of Chinese and western culture. We settle this opportunity down after the deadline of the final submission because we believe our project will be continued forever, and we will

Students will be able to experience **five-hour native classes** ranged

from Mathematics, English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Business, Economics, History, Design and Technology, Physical Education, Geography, Literature, Mandarin, Art, and Design and Textiles in English.



In closing, not only could our valuable project introduce the British education style to the students, but it also improves their English abilities via the practice of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. We hold the belief that all the students participated will be engaged well and they will harvest a lot from our classes.

We also distributed some **vocabulary tests** to the students in NKXY and randomly interviewed a few junior seven students in order to have a brief understanding and assessment about our efforts. The result is that more than half of the students participated in our project have been harvesting a lot, not only at the aspect of English vocabulary and cultivation, but also at the respect of their development and improvement of the etiquette and experiences on native English studying. Without a doubt, our project is exceedingly successful, which means that through our efforts, we not only helped a large quantity of students to develop and improve their English skills, but we also relatively reduced a tiny amount of inequality of English education resources in Tianjin after impacting hundreds of thousands of students and teachers in Tianjin. And we hope that our project would be able to help more people in need and spread to every part in China, even in the whole world. Our project is not a short one, instead, we will **definitely continue** to carry out it and do much more researches based on our assumption of the inequality of education resources, especially for English education resources. Moreover, for our following steps, we'll develop official accounts for WeChat account, Facebook, Instagram, and Twitters, & create our website on WIX to impact more people and begin to distribute English resources, such as A-LEVEL past papers, TOEFL vocabulary, etc. on these platforms.



Through our project, **equilibrated education** gave those students the knowledge of the world around them and changed it into their own civilization which improved themselves to grow mature and perform better. It helped them build on their own opinions, have their own critical thinking, and hold points of view on things in their future life. Education in our project made them capable of interpreting things, had a deep understanding and comprehension of their knowledge, and converted their knowledge to their performance in daily life.
