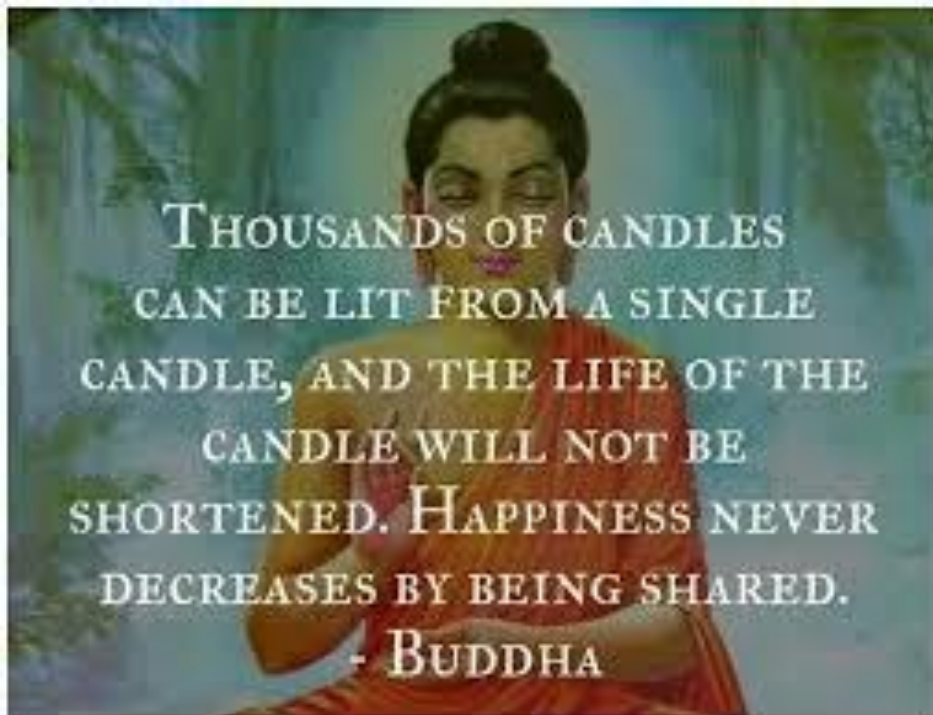

Their parents earned their livelihood by working at construction sites hence could not spend quality time with their children. Hence we thought it good to conduct a few games like quiz based on Christmas , balloon game and rewarded them with a chocolate. Finally we also narrated the story of the birth of Jesus Christ .A group of girls sang Christmas carols.

Then we distributed sweet to the other students too. We were delighted to see a smile on their face as they enjoyed the games and the carols. We experienced a deep sense of satisfaction that by spending quality time with the kids.

Hence as responsible leaders we first identified the equipment and resources which were lacking at the Saint Andrew's School. About which we have already mentioned in the previous report. The first step was to raise fund and accept donations. We advertised for the fund raiser at the Radio Jockey held in the school, where the student RJ interviewed us and we shared information about

the project and our plans. Every day we used to go around to the classes collecting donations from staff and students. After about a month we managed to make fair amount of collection of stationary, books and soft toys . Besides Our trustee Madam was kind to donate books from the school library. The school librarian Mrs. Tanjua Pandit generously donated books of different genres along with a lot of reference books worth INR10,000 . Besides, several sports equipment worth INR 1,581 which included a cricket set, badminton set, football, soft toys, skipping ropes, foam rings and a chess board were purchased and donated.

On the 18<sup>th</sup> March,2019 we visited the school once again with the donations . All the books, sports equipment and soft toys were donated to the students who received it with a broad smile on their face. The books were distributed to the students and instructions were given by the Principal of St.Andrew's school, Mr. Ahire to keep the books in their library so that the children could avail of the books as and when required and could also utilize their time reading and plunging themselves in a world of fantasy.. The sports equipment were also given to the students . They were given instructions as to how to play and were also the basic rules. It was seen that were no less than prodigies. They were soon seen playing really well. And enjoying the games. The soft toys were also received happily by the little ones who promised to keep it in the class and would use it as and when time permitted.

We also interviewed the principal , and thanked him for giving us an opportunity to carry out our project in his campus. We also had the opportunity to talk to talk to the teachers.

We returned with a deep sense of gratification for all the efforts we had put in.. So it is basically such a thing in India that people have talent but no resources and thanks to GSL team to give us a chance to this reality about India.
