OUR GOAL AND PURPOSE

Our goal was to work with an animal shelter that helps that helps street dogs. We wanted to collect the money for the animal by selling bookmarks and holding an exhibition. .we were be able to do 3-4 visits in about 1 months to get to know the how many dogs there,how many are ill and the other supplies they needed

we started with identifying an organization that helps dogs because we see that the dogs on the streets are not being kept and treated well We also connect with other organizations that help other animals that go through animal cruelty..And we connected with THE POSH FOUNDATION

PLANING OUR ACTIONS

We first noted our interests and then we planned what we were going to do. We then started making the handmade bookmarks, quotes and gift tags for the Diwali Mela in Mishti's society. We collected around ₹9000/-. After that we still needed more funds so we planned to take a stall on the Christmas Carnival in school, in which we collected ₹10,000/-. After a month or so we went to posh foundation and met all the dogs over there and we also had a chat with Ms. Nidhi and then gave the cheque to Ms.Nidhi.

TAKING ACTION

In October we came up with a plan to sell handmade bookmarks, gift tags, small and big quotes at a Diwali Mala. In November one of the other groups held a bake sale where we put up one of our stalls, we only sold bookmarks and we earned about ₹1000/-. In December we had Christmas Carnival on the 19th, where we sold our bookmarks and wall quote. At first, we didn't have many customers, but after 1 and a half hour we had sold around 15-20 bookmarks and 5-6 wall quotes. In January we can back to school on the 15th of Jan, we were looking forward to getting the money that we earn on the carnival. We got to know that we only earned ₹10,000/-. We found out that to complete the wish list we had to earn 7 thousand more, luckily Ms. Sakshi suggested that we start planning to sell our bookmarks during Read-A-Thon to complete our goal to collect 7 thousand more. In March On the 4th, we were able to visit the posh foundation and were able to give Ms.Nidhi a check of "seventeen thousand" for the animal rescue van, we took a little tour of the place and saw many dogs that are being treated and some of them were blind or recovering. We all had a hand in taking these actions. This helped the foundation fix there animal rescue van which helps them carry injured animals to their community.



HOW IS OUR PROJECT RELATED TO SDGS

Our motive was to help Posh foundation by giving them helping them get what they need. Made we made handmade goods like bookmarks, wall quotes, gift-tags, etc, and sold them. We had a lot of fun making bookmarks, wall quotes, etc. But we did experience a lot of problems as well as 1 of our teammate could not come to school on some days and so she missed many another important part of our project.

We have learned a lot from this project as we were able to develop skills like communication, thinking skills, Risk-taking skills, etc. Thinking skills because when we started with our project we made calls to different organizations where we could work, through that we got in touch with posh foundation and were able to start our project.during the Diwali mala, we were able to speak to our customers about our project and encouraged them to help us and the foundation.
