Nearly 775m people in the world are illiterate, nearly 8.7m people in Thailand do not get quality education, and 50m people can not speak English.

5 GENDER EQUALITY



Primary school completion rate for girls in school was 89% while the completion rate for boys was 97%. Men in Thailand receives more opportunities than women.

10 REDUCED INEQUALITIES



Thailand is one of many unequal countries relating to wealth (7.2% under poverty line) and some don't have the opportunity to study English. So, we decided to teach English to reduce the inequality in our society.

13 CLIMATE ACTION



In 2019, global temperature rose 0.85°C which was the hottest year recorded of all time. We aim to raise awareness about global warming and how to live a sustainable life.



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- ACTIONS -

RAISING MONEY : We had raised 9,100 baht (\$280 USD, £ 225.60) in total from our 4 days of doing a bake sale at our school. We had donated 5,000 baht (154.13 USD, £ 123.96) to Baan Nokkamin and the other half will be donated to a different charity.

REFORM BOOTH : We organised a reform booth to teach students, parents, staff, and teachers about the global goals and how to live a sustainable life.

BOARD GAMES : Our team made board games based on the global goals to teach lower primary students about the global goals. They did not know anything about the global goals before, but after the teaching session, everyone could answer questions the easily.

TEACHING AT BAAN NOKKAMIN FOUNDATION : Our team collaborated with ECO E.D.U to teach 20-30 students at Baan Nokkamin Foundation. At the foundation, we started with a 'Get to know' activity and then separated the children there into 3 groups and started to teach about The Global goals, the importance of each goal and the importance of recycling. After the teaching sessions, we organized fun activities for everyone to work as a team promoting togetherness.

About BAAN NOKKAMIN FOUNDATION

Team Hand in Hand and Team ECO E.D.U collaborated to teach at Baan Nokkamin Foundation. The Foundation (Bangkok, Thailand) is a Christian based charity which is primarily dedicated to help street children, orphans, children of broken families and children at risk; giving them a new warm, loving, caring environment and family.

CHALLENGES

- Our team has planned many different lesson plans to teach young children, but when we got to the Foundation, the majority of children there were older than we expected, so there were changes of plans.
- The next challenge we've faced is the pandemic outbreak of COVID-19. There were lots of hesitations on going to the foundation, but we ended up going anyway. We protected ourselves and others by wearing masks, and washing our hands consistently!

THE IMPACT WE CREATED

- We went to the orphanage to educate orphans and did some activities that helped them learn about the global goals etc.
- We sold bake goods around Ascot International School to raise money donate to Baan Nokkamin Foundation and other charities who will use that money to supply food and other resources.
- We impacted people in our school, out of school and online by raising awareness through educational videos, posts, posters, teaching, and through playing board games.
- On the first days of the bake sale, we used plastic containers which made us feel terrible so we decided to give the cake baker an idea to deliver the cake in big reusable containers instead and this idea worked! We felt amazing knowing the impact we created.

SUSTAINABILITY/ FUTURE PLANS

Team Hand in Hand and Team ECO E.D.U will merge to become one group and we will be continuing our actions by helping and donating to different charities in Thailand. There are many people who are interested to join us after viewing our social media platforms which will help us develop our team into a community.
