# **MEAL SCHEME**

We started off with providing breakfast for 8 underprivileged kids who couldn't have a proper meal to start off their day with as some of them didn't have parents or their family members were unemployed. After this initiative, other people joined in to feed these children and now

the number of kids having a meal has extended to 20+. We did this by tying up with a charitable trust which helps to pay for their long-term meals as this project was meant to be SUSTAINABLE. Now these children can have a healthy breakfast to start their school academics with on a long-term basis.
