The objective of our project was to donate books to a group of low-income children in Guatemala to help them develop the habit of reading. Another goal for our project was to involve the entire

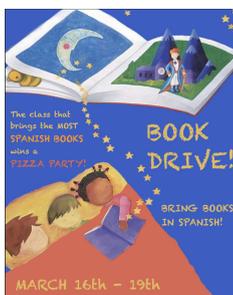

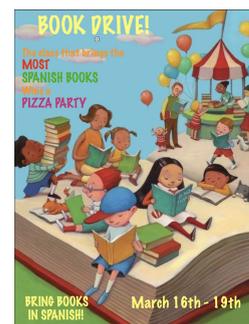
### Our Process
