Competition in Numbers



- Height of the competition active in 687 Schools, 105 Countries
- During global lockdown we received 249 final submissions from 49 of countries
- 117 made it to the semi-finals
- Young People Involved, 1247 (average 5 per team)
- Hours Spent, 43,823 (average 176 per project, 35 per young person)
- People Impacted, 97,492 (average 392 per project, 78 per young person)






