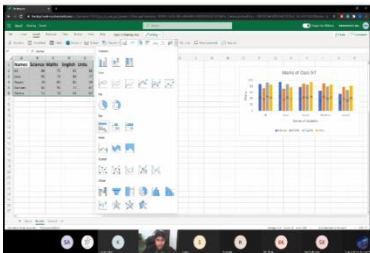


TECH FOR ALL

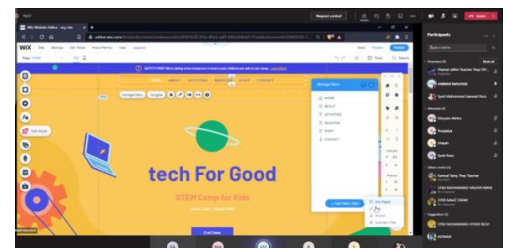

are not aware about this. And that was the moment when we as a team agreed not to stop this E-service learning program until each kid around us, our community and country is known to the miracle of education.

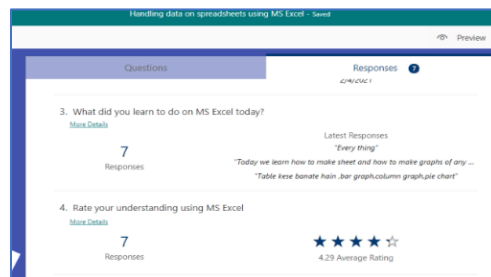
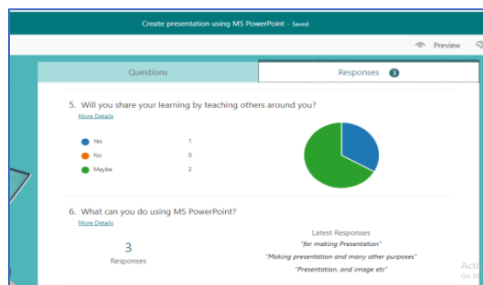
Our Achievements:
