



Attendee Code of Conduct

Global Social Leaders (GSL) Festival

This Code of Conduct sets out how we expect attendees to behave at the festival, this includes our speakers, parents or guardians of young people, adults and young people.

This is about creating a safe space for everyone and living our values as the GSL movement. We will have moderators in the festival rooms, who can remove anyone who is not abiding by this code.

Please ensure that you have read and understood our Code of Conduct before you complete the 'Agreement Form' which is a live link which has been sent in the email!

PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL SESSIONS ARE RECORDED FOR INTERNAL USE ONLY. This is in case of any safeguarding issues, and all recordings are deleted after one month.

By signing this Code of Conduct you understand that any behaviour that is not in line with expectations can lead to you being removed from a room, and unable to attend future sessions.

By signing the Code of Conduct, I agree to:

- Take responsibility for my own behaviour
- Enter the rooms using my real name, this helps hosts to know who is entering against the attendee list
- Help to establish and maintain a positive and supportive environment
- Treat all attendees and their opinions with respect, cultural sensitivity and politeness
- Stick to topics related to the event and in discussions as my participation and conduct in discussion forums is monitored
- Be supportive and constructive when offering feedback to others in collaborative group tasks or discussion
- Turn off or keep mobile phones on silent during sessions when I am not on mute so as to not distract the rest of the group
- Dress appropriately for sessions, especially when in the streams where I will be seen on video
- Attend from a suitable and appropriate location, such as a shared family room or classroom (for young people attending). I will have an appropriate background and be in a place with minimal background noise









 Share any concern that I have about another attendee with the room moderator, if appropriate, or with the Safeguarding Team. To let a moderator or Host of a room know immediately if I feel unsafe in a room or breakout room

By signing the Code of Conduct, I agree to NOT:

- Share the details of the programme log ins with anyone else as I understand that this is part of the Safeguarding of young people
- Share personal details or arrange to meet with anyone I do not know outside of the festival
- Use racist, sexist, homophobic, abusive terms, swear words or language that may cause offence
- Post, upload or file share anything off-topic, offensive, abusive or illegal using the chat function in rooms
- Post or upload inappropriate messages, content or spam using the chat function in a room
- Take pictures of the festival sessions at any point either by screenshot, using a camera, phone or other methods. Sharing of any images taken is also not allowed on any media platforms
- Record for either personal reference or to share with others or media platforms any
 of the festival sessions
- Share unauthorised advertising or promotional material using the chat function

Adult attendees additionally agree:

- To protect and safeguarding the young people by abiding by the following:
- NOT to share personal information including any form of contact details with young people attending the festival
- NOT to ask young people for their contact details
- NOT to attend the student stream sessions, unless you are the parent/guardian of a child under 13 years of age
