Actions

- Sold seed pencils and cloth bags to raise funds and donate to organizations that plant trees. All the funds that we raised will be donated to organizations to do waste segregation.
- We sold cloth bags as they reduce plastic usage, and 1 cloth bag saves 4 plastic bags. A
 Cloth bag can be reused as if you use it for 10 days it will save 400 plastic bags.

- We spread awareness in various grades in our school with kindergarten students. We
 made it highly informative and age appropriate to encourage and inspire students to act.



Impact of our actions

- When we segregate waste, it reduces the amount of waste that reaches landfills, due to that it will take up less space. Pollution of
 air and water can be reduced when hazardous waste is separated and treated separately. Waste must be put in separate bins so
 that it can be dealt with in a courteous manner instead of harming the environment. We have collaborated with "One Step
 Greener" to create a bigger impact
- We are trying to raise funds by selling seed pencils made from recycled paper and cloth bags to plant about 170+ trees, and many
 trees can absorb 5100kgs of CO2 a year. Shop keepers are inspired and are distributing the cloth bags with our placard.
- Our neighbour hood is inspired by our actions, and they have published our actions and thoughts to make a change in the local newspaper.
- My parent's office has stopped using plastic glasses and has switched to glass for drinking water.
