#### **OUR STORY**

When we started our project, we wanted to come up with an efficient alternative for plastic. But while researching, we got to know that paper accounts for more than 26% of total wastes at landfills. That is when we got to know all we had to do was, 'recycle paper to replace plastic'. That is when Greenager came to be. We, at Greenager, firmly believe that 'paper clay', made from waste paper, is the best alternative to plastic, being as effective, just more eco-friendly, and mainly, 100% biodegradable! This means that after using our paper clay products, users would not have to toss it into dustbins, but instead, into their own plants!

#### **OUR PREPARATION:**

Before conducting workshops and webinars ourselves, we attended several webinars and workshops like SaveTheSoil, and Sapere Aude ScienceFest on topics like climate science, aquaponics, and waste paper management.

#### **GAINS:**

While delving deep into the 3Rs was our major point of focus, we unknowing learnt the 3Cs too:

- 1. Cooperation Working towards a shared goal and supporting each other in our tasks made us realize that our cooperation and teamwork was our greatest strength.
- 2. Confidence Organizing events beyond our comfort zone and taking up challenges which seemed impossible to overcome actually boosted our confidence and self-esteem.
- 3. Communication Pitching and presenting our ideas in front of large audience definitely improved our public speaking and communication skills. We also learnt the power of persuasion and conviction in us.

### **SETBACKS:**

- Due to COVID-19 lockdowns, we weren't able to organize campaigns that we had previously planned. We also weren't able to reach out to people in our **community** personally to distribute paper clay products. However, we utilized all resources we had available, and conducted several webinars online. which actually expanded our audience, as people from around the world attended the webinars.
  - Even when our schools reopened. complying with regulations and precautionary measures, we weren't able to hold meetings with a large number of students at once or visit the school's garden in large groups. However, we planned visits in batches of students, and ourselves went to classes individually to hold workshops. Due to rigorous academic coursework, a
  - lot of our members weren't able to make time for Greenager, and often prioritized studies over it. But being driven to continue participating in Greenager activities, they agreed to often sacrifice lunch and breakfast breaks at school, and hold webinars during weekends and holidays.
- This way, Greenager stood strong amidst the setbacks. On the contrary, we gained cooperation and management skills. Thus we are now more equipped to face any challenges that may come our way.
