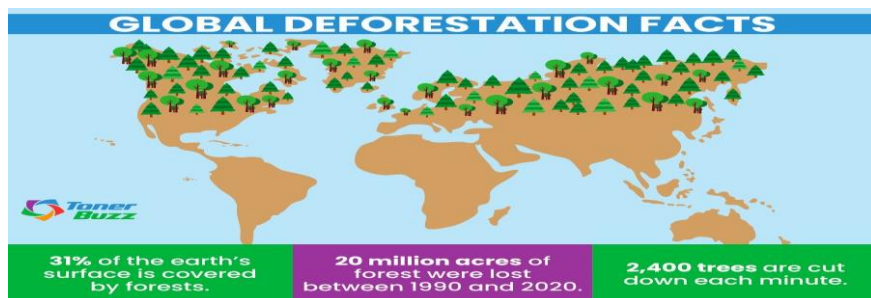

We attended many guest speaker sessions three of them were offline and two were online. We learnt about pollution and deforestation.

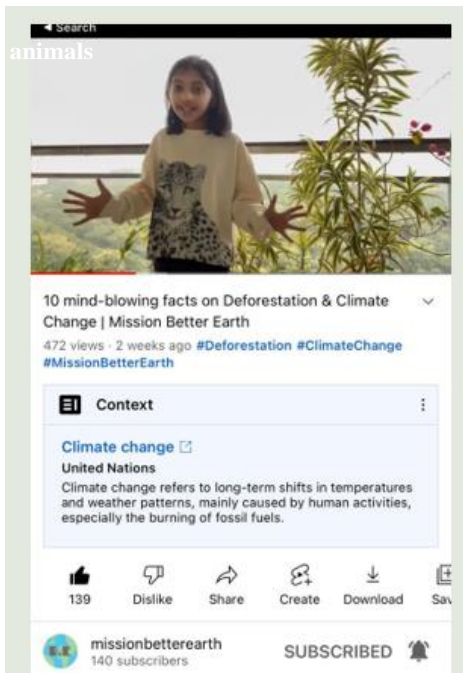
Plantation Drive



Target = Plant 1000 trees

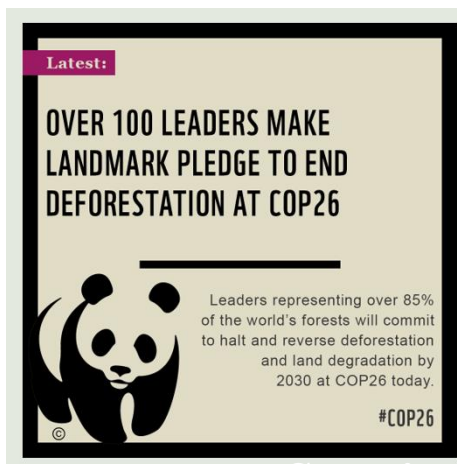
