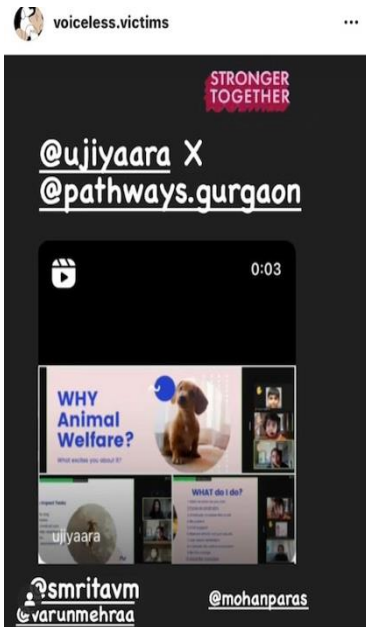
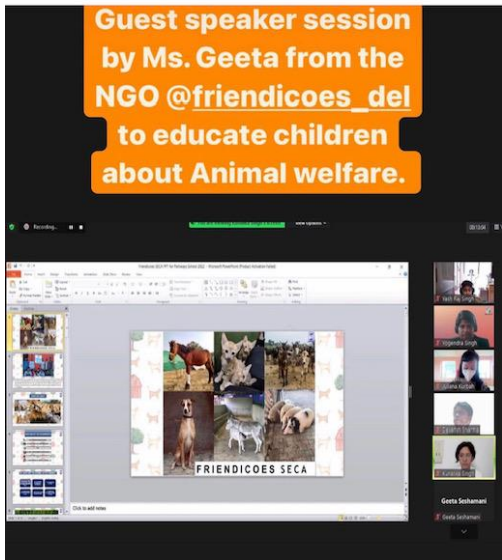
## Being Resourceful

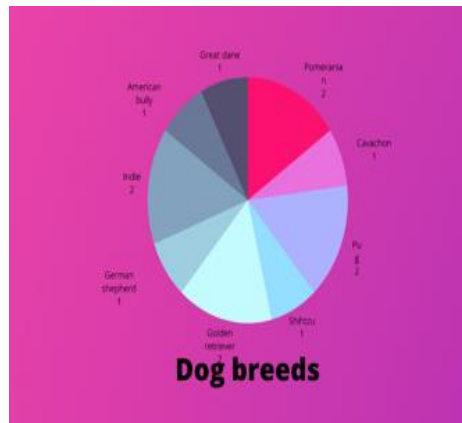
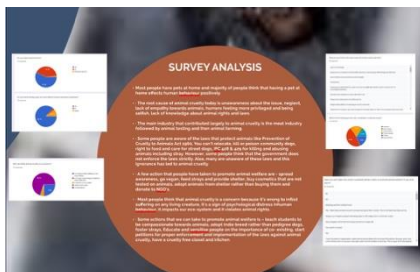


**Guest Speaker Session by NGO - Friendicoes** which was hosted by Ms. Geeta.

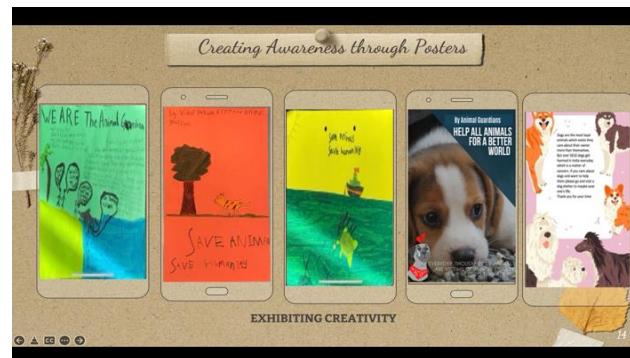
- She explained how these NGO's provide shelter, food and medical aid to the helpless animals.

We conducted various surveys to understand the issue better and collected responses from the community. This is the visual representation of the data collected.

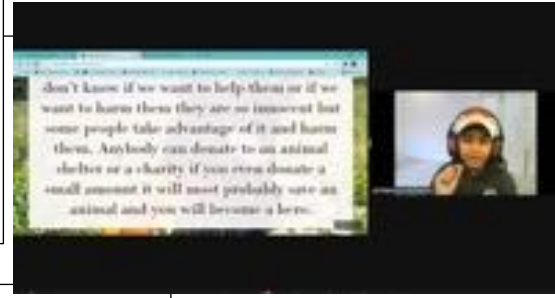


# Our Actions

With his fundraiser, the animal guardians donated 57 pounds to the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.



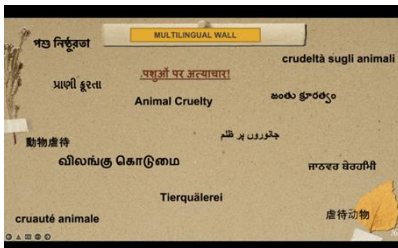

Yash interviewed Animal Rights activist, author and Politician Mrs. Maneka Gandhi to gain from her experience working with helpless animals through her NGO - People for Animals. Yash also raised INR 50K through his fundraiser which was donated to three NGO - People for Animals, Friendicoes and Astitva Animal welfare foundation. Voiceless victims fed 100 stray dogs in.

Yash also conducted a donation drive in his society to raise funds to buy 2 waterproof beds for the strays that live near his society. Together Yash, Viiren and Fateh, in collaboration with Stray Talk India, provided shelter to 50 dogs in Gurgaon by placing dog beds donated by Stray Talk India.
